# Umpire Roles & Responsibilities

# Pre-Match Duties

- Reporting Time: 10:00 AM (first match), 2:30 PM (second match)
- Toss Supervision: Ensure toss happens at 10:15 AM / 2:45 PM
- **Team Count Verification:** Ensure minimum 7 players are present per team before toss and match start
- Playing XI Submission: Verify team submissions and substitutes before start

# During the Match

#### Match Control:

- Enforce all game rules including over limits, powerplays, and time restrictions
- o Authorize or deny substitute fielders

#### Over Rate Enforcement:

Ensure 20th over starts by 95th minute;
otherwise penalize fielding side by reducing outside-the-circle fielders

### Ball Tampering Check:

- Monitor for use of saliva or foreign substances on the ball
- o Final authority on ball condition disputes
- Super Over Supervision: If a match is tied, organize and monitor super overs (up to 3, then bowl-out if needed)

### Rain Delay Management:

- o Apply DLS method where needed
- Ensure 5-over minimum is met to declare a valid match

#### • Code of Conduct Enforcement:

- Monitor and record player behaviour
- Issue demerit points as per offense levels (1–4)
- o A Level 4 offense leads to direct season ban

# Fair Play Scoring:

- Award 1 point for good conduct, 0 for poor
- Fair Play Award winner is decided by total points

# Tumpire Dress Code

#### **♦ When Teams Wear Dark Jerseys (as in LCC)**

- **Shirt: Umpires** must not wear white or light-coloured shirts **when white balls are in use.**
- Trousers: Trousers must be dark-coloured (e.g., black, navy, or dark grey), formal or smart-casual — no jeans or joggers.
- Hat/Cap: Umpires may wear a matching dark cap or hat (avoid white headwear).
- Shoes: Footwear should be black sports shoes with good grip no spikes.
- **Optional:** Sunglasses, stopwatch, sun sleeves (if wearing short sleeves)

Note: The aim is to ensure umpires are clearly visible and do not obstruct ball tracking visually.

### Umpire Meal Provision:

A free meal will be provided to all umpires on match days.

# Use of Cricheros App:

- Umpires are responsible for match scoring via the Cricheros app. The name of scorer will be published every week on website.
- Scoring details/logins are shared before match

# **Important Notes**

- Umpires to go through all the match rules at "LeedsChampionsCup.com/rules"
- Match fee will be transferred to umpires bank account after the match. Please share your bank details at leedschampionscup@gmail.com
- Umpires must inform captains at halfway mark if they are delayed
- Decisions by the main umpire are final and binding
- Any misconduct or alcohol use by players must be reported and may lead to bans
